

# Summer Youth Art Camp

Join us at the RAL Art Center this summer for six weeks of creative fun! Youth Art Camps will be held in the Art Center's Pike Studio beginning July 5 and continuing through August 12.



Session Times: Rising 1<sup>st</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> graders in the morning, 9:30 am - 12:30 pm Monday-Friday

Rising 6<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> graders in the afternoon, 1:00 - 4:00 pm Monday-Friday

Cost: Fees for one week of  $\frac{1}{2}$  day classes is **\$110 per week for RAL members; \$126 per week for non-members.** Registration is for full weeks only; missed days are not refunded. Please see cost exception for Art in the Round below.

**July 5 -8: *Art in the Round*** [Four days, Tuesday-Friday; \$88 for RAL members and \$100 for non-members.]



Join Lancaster Middle School Art Instructor Marilyn Sprouse in discovering the many ways to use 'round' in your art: create a mandala meant to transform sorrow into joy or to bring peace; sketch and paint using only Q-tips; weave a round wall hanging using varied materials; fold, arrange and paste to create a dimensional work of art that **MAY** be round; use found round things to print on a rock. Climb on the merry-go-ROUND!

**July 11-15: *Wild About Art***



Kids will be wild about producing their individual masterpieces using the many different arts media. RAL artist Juli Schuszler will guide students in creating an 8x10 acrylic painting of an owl, a watercolor painting of wildflowers and butterflies, a crayon-resist underwater scene, a pastel portrait of a bear, a mixed-media floral still life, and a mixed-

media artwork with a subject of their choosing. Students should bring a smock or large t-shirt to protect their clothing as it may get WILD!

### July 18-22: *Visual Arts Summer Sampler*



If you love art, then come sample our menu of awesome art projects. During this exciting week, students will learn and apply the elements and principles of art as they create one-of-a-kind works in ink, paint, charcoal, pastel and other exciting mediums.

Be bold, colorful, creative and a bit wacky as the week progresses. Our subjects will be varied, fun and beautiful. If you are looking for a unique art adventure then this is the one.

### July 25-29



**Morning: *Surf, Sand and Sea* [Class hours: 9:00-12:00. All ages are welcome]**

Calling all beach lovers! Spend a week creating sea creatures we all love — as well as a few that might be a bit scary! Create a beautiful seascape, a still life with seashells, draw and design a beach towel, flip flops and so much more. Students will learn skills and techniques to blend, layer, texture and shade. These classes will be messy, fun and full of excitement. RAL Executive Director Doug Mock will lead the group for 4 days, with a guest instructor on Friday.



**Afternoon: *The Art of Book Binding* [Class hours: 1:00-3:30; Grades 6-9; Class limit:8]**

This five-day course will cover the design, production and binding of a hard-covered journal. Join RAL artist Barbara Brecher as she will direct students in creating silk endpapers, designing a front and back cover, build a book block, and combine all these elements into a book.



**August 1-5: *Art Like the Masters***

Spend the week learning about and creating art like the masters! Students will paint, sculpt, print, draw and explore unusual art materials. Throughout the week, you will study and observe famous works of art, then create masterpieces of your very own. This week promises to be a whole lot of creative fun as you "master" these learning opportunities.



**August 8-12: *Tropical Art***

Pack your sunglasses and join us in a fantastic adventure to the tropics as we create unique works of art inspired by the warmer weather. From flowing palms to diving dolphins, from sandy beaches to colorful shells, daily projects promise to challenge your artistic vision. Students will go home each day with special works. Maybe a coconut sculpture?
